LEAVE OF ABSENCE/HOLIDAYS IN TERM TIME

Having a good education helps to open up more opportunities in adult life for our children. As parents you have a legal duty to ensure that your children attend school on a regular basis.

The Principal may not grant any leave of absence (holiday) during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances.

If you intend to take your child out of school please complete a notification of absence form well in advance of any planned absence. If the request is denied and you still decide to take your child out of school for a leave of absence then the absence will be coded as unauthorised. This may lead to a Fixed Penalty Notice being issued. We believe that regular and high attendance is in every pupil's best interests and helps to maximise their achievements and enjoyment of school. Evidence shows that children with poor attendance are unlikely to succeed academically. All schools have a statutory obligation to provide information to the local Authority regarding attendance.

Children in year 2 have completed some sensory activities to help improve their fine motor skills.




Year 6 are showing Olly organisation and cooperation during Team Teach in spellings this morning.





This week in Reception we have been creating houses. We have also talked about our real homes and who we live with.


CLASSROOM NEWS

We believe that a uniform gives a sense of belonging and pride in the academy, whilst ensuring equality amongst pupils. In addition, a smart appearance contributes positively to the pupils' attitude to work and learning; it also influences how the academy is portrayed to the general public and our visitors.

- Purple sweatshirt or cardigan with logo
- White Polo shirt
- Dark grey pinafore, skirt, culottes, trousers or shorts
- White, black or grey socks or tights
- Black shoes
- Purple gingham (checked) dresses (optional in summer)
- PE Kit
- black shorts, skort or jogging bottoms
- purple T-shirt with logo
- Plimsolls
- a drawstring bag

Please make sure that all clothing is named.

You can use a laundry marker pen or Sharpie marker to write names onto clothes.

All name labels should be on the *inside* of clothing and personal belongings. Please do not visibly "personalise" items, especially ruck sacks, bags and lunch boxes, as this enables familiarity from people your children do not know.
