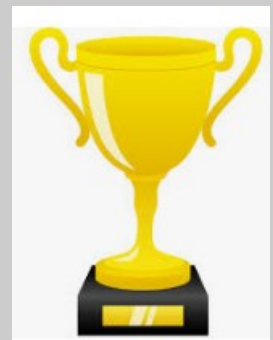

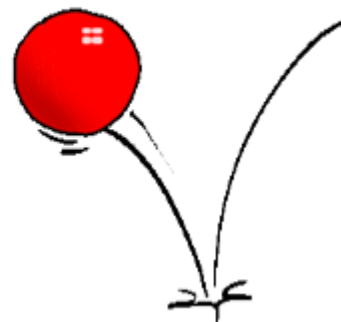

- **Lots of practical advice and ideas to build resilience in yourself and your family**



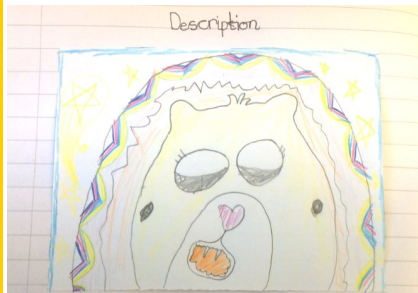
