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Home learning at Victoria Primary Academy



Home learning reinforces what your child is learning at the academy. It also gives you a chance to become involved in the learning process. At Victoria we feel it is a vital part of your child's learning and development.

In Reception reading is the most important homework. Your child may have a book from the classroom library in his or her bag – try to read together every night. You will be asked to fill in a 'reading diary' about your child's reading experiences.

Talk about their learning in school can be the most valuable homework of all, especially if you show interest and play an active role by asking your child questions about their day.

In Reception we love to celebrate the children's achievements and send home "stars" for you to write on about your children.
