





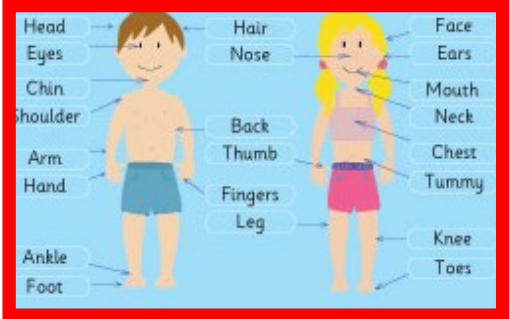


Long long ago old toys were often made of wood.	Now toys are often made of plastic.
