



Oversubscription Criteria for 2023-2024

The published admissions number for Victoria Primary Academy is 60. If the Academy receives more application for places than are available in the 'normal round' (that is the main cycle of applications for Reception places from the beginning of the school year) any appeals are administered on behalf of Hatton Academies Trust Primary school by North Northamptonshire Council's School Admissions Team as part of the local coordinated scheme.

Places will be allocated to pupils who have an Education, Health and Care (EHC) plan that names the academy as the appropriate provision. When there are more applications for places than there are available priority will be given in the following order:

1. Children in public care or previously in public care but immediately after being looked after become subject to an adoption, child arrangements order or special guardianship order.
2. Pupils with a brother or sister continuing at the school at the time of admission of the child.
3. Pupils who live closer to the preferred school than any other school.
4. Other pupils

Tiebreaker

If the admission number is exceeded within any criterion, priority will be given to those who live closest to Victoria Primary Academy.

Distances are measured on a straight-line basis from the address point of the child's home to the address point of the school, using a geographical information system. Each address has a unique address point established by the most valuable elements from the National Land and Property Gazetteer (NPLG), Ordnance Survey Master Map, Royal Mail Postal Address File and The Valuation Office Agency. The address point for a property does not change.
