

Creating Learners Without Limits

Phonics:

The table below shows the groups the children progress through in the Read Write Inc. programme from Set 1 – A, usually at the beginning of Year R, through to Grey in Year 2. We would expect children to move at least one group every term.

Set 1 – A (recognise a few or no single letter sounds)	<i>In these groups the children learn Set 1 sounds and learn how to blend sounds to read words</i>
Set 1 – B (recognise most single letter sounds)

Ditty	<i>In these groups, the children learn the Set 1 digraphs and read words containing these sounds</i>

Green	<i>In these groups, the children learn Set 2 sounds and read words containing these sounds</i>

Yellow	<i>In these groups, the children learn the Set 3 sounds and read words containing these sounds</i>

Get Writing:

Each writing activity has a purpose, this supports the children to understand the skills they are learning and why.

Hold a Sentence 1 and 2	<i>To hold a sentence in our heads before writing it with correct spelling and punctuation</i>
Build a Sentence	<i>To build a sentence out loud</i>
Write about...	<i>To write a composition based on the book using the six key steps for writing</i>
Proofread	<i>To correct spelling and punctuation errors</i>

Activity	Purpose
Red Rhythms – Spelling Red Words	<i>To spell red words correctly</i>
Fred Fingers – Spelling Green Words	<i>To spell Green Words correctly</i>
Hold a Sentence 1 and 2	<i>To hold a sentence in our heads before writing it with correct spelling and punctuation</i>
Build a Sentence	<i>To build a sentence out loud before writing it down</i>
Spell Check	<i>To check we can spell the Red and Green Words</i>
Grammar	<i>To learn and practise new grammar skills</i>
Vocabulary	<i>To learn new and interpret vocabulary to use in our writing</i>
Write about...	<i>To write a composition based on the book using the six key steps for writing</i>
Proofread – spelling and grammar	<i>To correct spelling and punctuation errors</i>
Spell Test	<i>To celebrate the words we can spell and identify words we need to practice</i>
Words to Keep	<i>To select our favourite words from our Write About to use in future writing</i>
