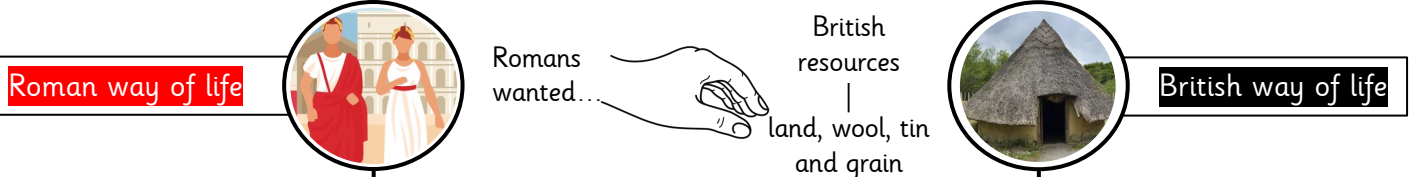

location (map icon) **Italy** (map of Italy) capital city = **Rome** organised nation

location (map icon) **Britain** (map of Britain) tribes, villages and kings sporadic tribes

settlement (temple icon) towns and cities villas public baths Forum

settlement (huts icon) villages small round houses wooden forts to protect

people (person icon) Romans ruled by an emperor: Caesar, Claudius, Hadrian powerful army

people (person icon) smaller tribes ruled by kings and queens: Caractacus & Boudicca British Celts: farmers, craftspeople

way of life (gears icon) many different jobs luxurious houses villas entertainment: Amphitheatre

way of life (gears icon) farmers and craftspeople round houses small villages & forts no towns

belief (person icon) believed in gods look like people Jupiter

belief (person icon) druids: British priests believed gods were spirits in everything: mountains, trees, lakes

technology (person icon) some could read and write (Latin) rule of law measurement - miles Public buildings: roads and towns sewers and plumbing aqueducts

technology (person icon) craftspeople: skilled in metal & woodwork fine jewellery only a few could read and write
