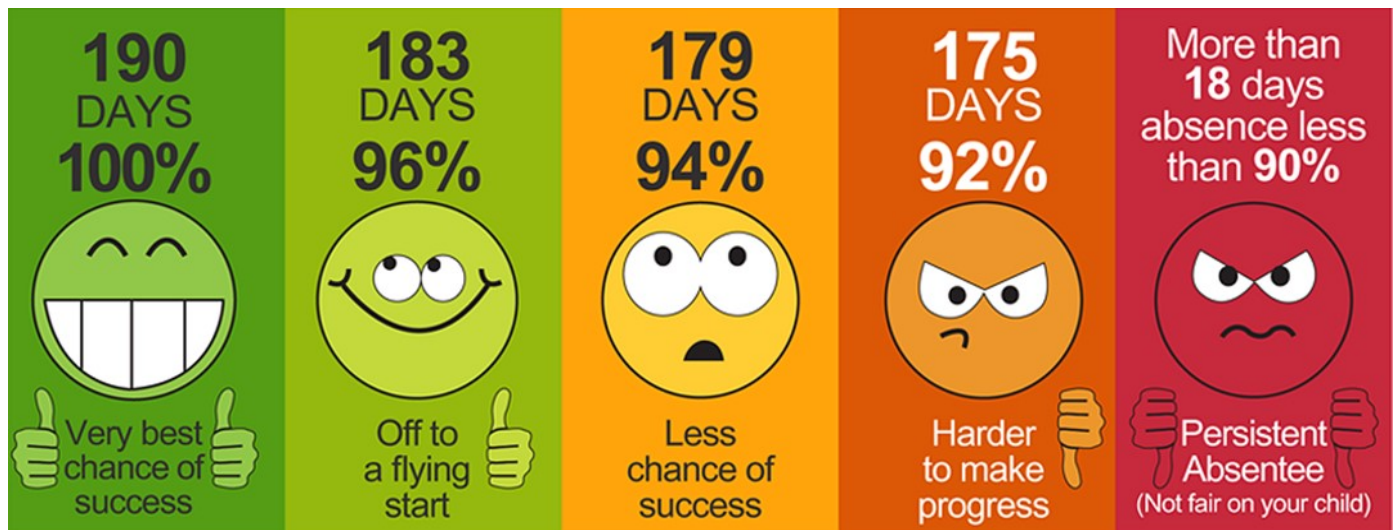

Absence for sickness, or for other reasons, just before or just after a school holiday may be queried. If we are unable to contact you, or if your child has more than 2 days of sickness, we may conduct a home visit.



This is part of our attendance and safeguarding procedures.



- **Regular school attendance** is an important part of giving your child the best possible start in life and is important to your child's future.
- Of the 365 days in a year, 190 days are in school and 175 days are non-school days to spend with family, friends, on holiday, shopping or appointments.
- **Our aim is to achieve 96%** attendance for our pupils which represents good attendance and is shown in the traffic light graph above.
- If you attended a parent consultation you will have received an update of your child's attendance status. Please consider carefully whether your child needs to stay off school for a minor illness or before you arrange time off during term time, and the amount of learning they have missed if they are **persistently absent (less than 90%)**.

If you do not know your child's attendance status, please ask for information at the school office.
